18 APOLOGIES FOR ABSENCE

An apology for absence was received from PCSO K. Harris.

19 MINUTES – 2 MAY 2017

The minutes of the Annual Meeting held on 2nd May 2017 were agreed as a correct record and signed by the Chairman.

20 DECLARATIONS OF INTEREST

G. Moore declared an interest in item 8(a) on the agenda (planning applications).

21 POLICE REPORT

PCSO K. Harris was unable to attend the meeting. The report received contained crime prevention advice. The Clerk reported there was one incident reported in April shown on the crime mapper website. This occurred in the Binsey area.

22 PUBLIC PARTICIPATION

Members of the public present were invited to raise any matters in relation to matters on the agenda.

David and Cathy Rooney were in attendance and advised members that they are trained as Dementia Champions and are giving talks to various groups to raise awareness of the needs of people living with dementia and their carers and to create Dementia Friends. The Church Council of St. James, Ireby have requested their support to help them work towards making Ireby a Dementia Friendly Community. The backing of the Parish Council was requested. Support has also been requested from local businesses in and around the Ireby and Uldale area. Mr. Rooney advised that the project will be extended to Uldale with businesses in Uldale already involved.

Members confirmed they were willing to support the request in principle and will await further information as to any involvement that may be required from the parish council.

The annual return had been submitted to the external auditors.

The Clerk reported that she had spoken to the owner of the land at Ruthwaite to discuss the issues raised at the March meeting. The land owner had confirmed that she was in discussion with the LDNPA regarding erecting some buildings on the land and the Environmental Health Department at the Borough Council had visited the area and raised no concerns in relation to the welfare of the animals. With regard to erecting a fence to separate the parish land the owner had confirmed that as she did not intend to keep livestock on this area did not feel it was necessary to erect a fence.

Three requests for donations had been received.

Ireby School

Members considered the letter from Ireby School PTA requesting financial assistance towards the repair of the school/village play area. The estimate for the repair is £500 and the parish council had been requested to make a contribution towards this. The letter also asked whether the parish council would consider making an annual donation towards the upkeep of the grounds. Two proposals of £200 and £100 were considered. Following a vote, it was **RESOLVED** that £100 should be granted towards the repairs. The request for an annual contribution would be considered at the January meeting when the parish precept is set.

Ireby and Uldale PCC

The annual requests for donations towards the maintenance of the churchyards at Ireby and Uldale were considered. Three different proposals of £200, £150 and £120 were put forward for consideration. After a discussion, a vote was taken on each proposal. It was therefore **RESOLVED** that the amount of £120.00 be granted to St. James Church Uldale and a similar amount to St James Church Ireby.
