### **42 MINUTES – 5 SEPTEMBER 2017**

The minutes of the meeting held on 5<sup>th</sup> September 2017 were agreed as a correct record and signed by the Chairman.

### **43 DECLARATIONS OF INTEREST**

No declarations of interest were received.

### **44 POLICE REPORT**

The letter received from Inspector Rachel Gale regarding the new procedures for police engagement with Parish Councils was discussed. The letter stated that it was not feasible for an officer to attend each individual parish council meeting. For a trial period regular meetings will be held every 10 weeks to which all parish councils within the officer's area of responsibility will be invited. It was noted that the meeting due to be held at the end of October had been cancelled. The Clerk reported that information on the crime mapper website stated that one incident of anti social behaviour had been reported on or near Sun Croft Ireby and six crimes had been reported in or near the Binsey area in August 2017.

**49 HIGHWAYS/HIGHWAY MAINTENANCE**

Notification of road closures had been received from County Highways for Snittlegarth for a period of 3-5 days from 9<sup>th</sup> November and Ireby for a period of five weeks from 20<sup>th</sup> November.

R. Cockburn reported that some work appears to have been done at Snittlegarth but there is no evidence that the gully wagon had visited High Ireby.

The Chairman reported that the culvert under the Ireby to Daleside road between the Guards and Aughertree road end is still blocked and the reflectors on the low side of the road still need to be installed.

K. Bridges reported that the work required at Uldale had still not been done.

B Hinde asked whether the parish seats that had been uplifted for the pavement works in Ireby would be reinstated once the work had been completed.

Cllr Bowness agree to pursue these matters with County Highways and would also chase R. Manchester to undertake an inspection of the roads in the parish.
