42 HIGHWAYS

(a) Highway Maintenance

The Chairman reported that he had met with representatives from Highways regarding the flooding at the sewage works at Ireby. The drains have been jetted but no additional work will be carried out until the next financial year. Members agreed to monitor the area.

It is still unclear as to whether any work had been carried out on the High Ireby road.

It was requested that the road sweeper visit the parish. The Clerk agreed to contact the Borough Council.

(b) Speeding Issues

Residents' concerns were again discussed regarding the speed of some vehicles approaching Ireby from Boltongate. It was agreed that the County Council be contacted to request speed monitoring be carried out at this location. The PCSO would also be contacted to enquire if advice could be provided on setting up a community speed watch group.

43 DONATION REQUESTS

Requests for financial assistance had been received from Citizens Advice Allerdale, St James Church, Ireby and St. James Church Uldale. The requests were considered by members. RESOLVED that the following donations be granted:

44 TUBS/PLANTERS

Further to minute ref. 23 Cllr Hey advised members that he would like to donate some old whisky barrels to the parish to be used as planters. Potential locations and the maintenance of the tubs once planted was discussed. It was agreed that two tubs would be sited in Uldale and two in Ireby. Cllrs Bridges and Heys agreed to liaise with regard to exact locations bearing in mind any health and safety implications.

45 RECYLING IN THE PARISH

Members noted that the Borough Council will be reinstating the suspended recycling service on 9th September. It was reported that confusion still exists particularly in Uldale with the paper/cardboard collection service. The Clerk was requested to seek clarification on the recycling service that will be provided in the parish.

46 NORTHERN FELLS BROADBAND GROUP

Correspondence had been received from Northern Fells Broadband Group enclosing a cheque for £300.00. The Group had been set up approximately ten years ago and had now agreed to wind up as most of the area has provision of either wireless or fibre based service. The Clerk was requested to acknowledge the letter and thank NFBG for the cheque.
